PREPARATION FOR EXTERMINATION

1. REDUCE CLUTTER. Bag items after inspecting them. Replace on treated surface within 2 days of treatment.
2. Cover all Fish/Reptile tanks. Turn off air to the tank.
3. Remove all linens, pillows, stuffed animals and blankets from all beds dry at high heat. This should be done daily.
4. Remove all curtains from windows and dry at high heat.
5. Empty all drawers in infested areas so they can be treated.
6. Remove any pet food that is out in the open.
7. Be prepared To Vacate the apartment for 4-10 hours. IF PREGNANT PLEASE CALL FOR SPECIFIC DIRECTIONS!
8. Be prepared to remove animals (cats/dogs etc.) for several hours if a complete residence treatment is proposed
9. Vacuum floors. After you have vacuumed place a small amount of baby/talcum powder onto the floor and suck into vacuum to kill any insects that are in the bag. Bag vacuum bag and throw away.
10. Bag books on 2 lower shelves so we can treat the shelves. Place back on shelving after treatment and all surfaces are dry.
11. Dry clean delicates/suits. Bag them afterwards. In some cases these items may be dried at low to moderate heat without damage-check with the manufacturer.
12. Leave all clothing in bags until area is determined to be pest free. We recommend this until after second scheduled treatment and no bites are occurring.
13. Purchase covers for mattress and box spring. Prior to (if activity is high) or after initial treatment cover and tape openings closed with duct tape if not bed bug proof. Box Springs should be thrown away at the second month and replaced with an encased box spring.

14. Make sure we can access areas behind furniture to properly treat. We will not move heavy items and will not be responsible for untreated areas
15. If couch or other upholstered items are contaminated throw out. Wrap in plastic prior to moving. Mark with spray paint to discourage others from taking back into the building or destroy.
16. Inform Pest Control Operator of any Health issues: such as prgnancy/asthma/reduced lung capacity/etc.
17. We recommend small children (under 3) and vacate the premises for at least 24-48 hours.
18. Do not touch treated areas until dry.
19. DO NOT TREAT YOURSELF USING FOGGERS OR OVER-THE-COUNTER BOMBS
20. Do not disturb dust around perimeter of walls.
21. Remember you must live in an infested unit to ensure continued bed bug activity so that they become exposed to the treatment products. If you leave for an extended time during the treatment program it is probable that it will fail.
22. Box Springs, couches, stuffed chairs are a particularly difficult area to treat. Note that the cloth covers at the bottom will be removed during the treatment program if they are suspect.
